### Engineering Scholarship

Students eligible for any of the four presidential scholarship awards and majoring in engineering are also eligible for an Engineering Scholarship of \$1,000 a year, renewable for four years. Students must maintain a 3.0 to keep their scholarship.

### Klamath County \$1000 Scholarship

Students who qualify for a Presidential Scholarship AND graduated from a high school in Klamath County are eligible for a one-year non-renewable scholarship of \$1,000. Transfer students are not eligible for the Klamath County scholarship.

### Other Eligibility Criteria\*

Students enrolled in the OHSU Nursing program, Pre-Medical Lab Science, Medical Lab Science, Pre- Paramedic, Paramedic, and post-baccalaureate courses are not eligible for these scholarships. Additionally, International Students, students attending Oregon Tech through the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program, students receiving reciprocity, and Online Education are not eligible for these scholarships.

Prior to entering the OHSU Nursing program, Pre-Nursing students are eligible for the scholarships.

### Engineering Scholarship

### Klamath County \$1000 Scholarship
