# Kudos 2014–2015

- \$500,000 in student scholarships awarded by Oregon Tech Foundation for first time in university's history!





# Kudos 2014–2015

- CoARC recognition of Oregon Tech's Respiratory Care Program among the top 2% in the nation
- Oregon Tech student chapter of Institute of Transportation Engineers place 1<sup>st</sup> at 2014 Oregon ITE Traffic Bowl.



# Kudos 2014–2015

- Oregon Tech *USNews*' #8 Best Baccalaureate College in Western US; #2 Most Efficient College in Western US
- Oregon Tech ranks #156 (>1200 colleges & universities) in Educate to Career ranking (most improvement in potential earnings of students)



# Kudos 2014–2015

- Oregon Tech ranks #499 in *Forbes* top colleges in US (#93 in western US; #3 public in OR)

  - Concrete-Canoe Team

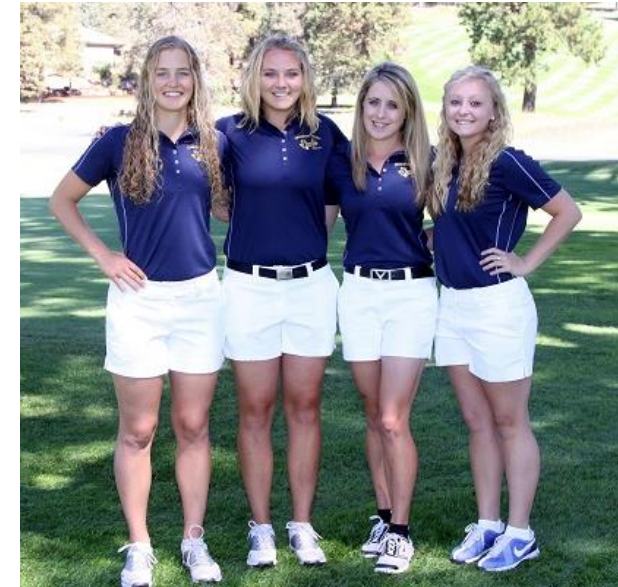




# Student Accomplishments 2014–2015

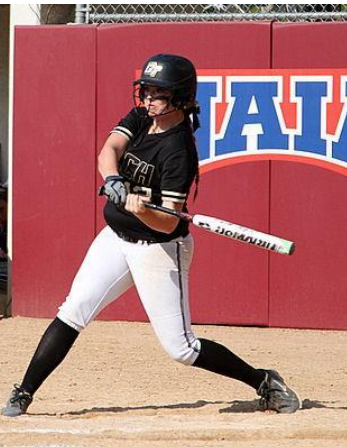
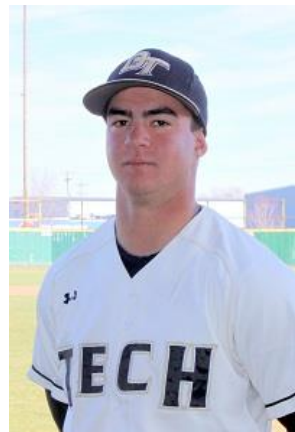
