2015-16 Investments (\$465K)

- Increase success for +120 first-gen, lowincome students (up 75%) – advising, peer consulting, mentoring
- Academic assistance texting program for 70 students
- 150 "Completer" scholarships
- Systemic outreach to targeted student populations (VP Enrollment Management)



2016 Priorities

- \$55M for Public University Support Fund
 - -Drafting bill that directs each institution to invest the \$27.5M in 2nd year of biennium
 - -Oregon Tech estimated amount: \$725K
- Reauthorize University Venture
 Development Fund



Potential Issues in 2016



- Adjunct health care benefits (est. \$3.8M biennium)
- Minimum wage (est. \$500K)
- Accelerated learning
- Free community college
- Student health records/sexual assault
- Ballot measure to increase revenue for education and other services via corporate tax increase
