Turf striping typically lasts the life of the turf.

There is no snow removal to avoid damage to the turf with equipment. A light dusting might be broomed off by athletes, otherwise, cancel use.

Conditioning is not required. Some facilities do it annually, others I spoke with have never even heard of doing it.

Using 12 year replacement cycle as we will not approach the 2,400 hours a year that would be associated with facilities such as Delta Park in Portland. I would anticipate closer to 1,200 hours/year
