

## **How to Create an Assignment**

- 1. Navigate to the content area in which you would like the assignment to display. This might in the area labeled "Assignments," or you might simply wish to load the assignment directly in the Course Materials area.
- 2. Either way hover your cursor over the "Assessments" button and choose "Assignment" from the drop-down menu.



3. On the "Create Assignment" page, fill out the "Assignment Information" area including title and instructions. If your assignment is already in PDF format, you can also choose to browse for the file to add as an attachment. Be sure to include the "Points Possible" in the "Grading" area. You can also add a rubric in this area as well. Be sure to specify a due date in the "Due Dates" area so that the due date will appear on the course Dashboard.



4. There are links you can click to open labeled "Submission Details," "Grading Options," or "Display of Grades." The last two areas you usually won't want to change anything in. However in the "Submission Details" section, you may want to configure things like number of allowable attempts. If you will be distributing the assignment to specific and previously created groups of students, be sure to select the "Group Submission" radio button. Otherwise, you can leave the "Individual Submission" radio button selected. You can select the option to use SafeAssign plagiarism tool if you wish.

If any students are enrolled in more than one group receiving the same assignment they will submit more than one attempt for this assignment. It may be necessary to provide these students with an overall grade for the assignment.

5. In the "Availability" section, you can choose to only allow the assignment to be available during certain days/times. Don't forget to leave the checkmark in front of "Make the Assignment Available." Be sure to click "Submit" to deploy the assignment.
