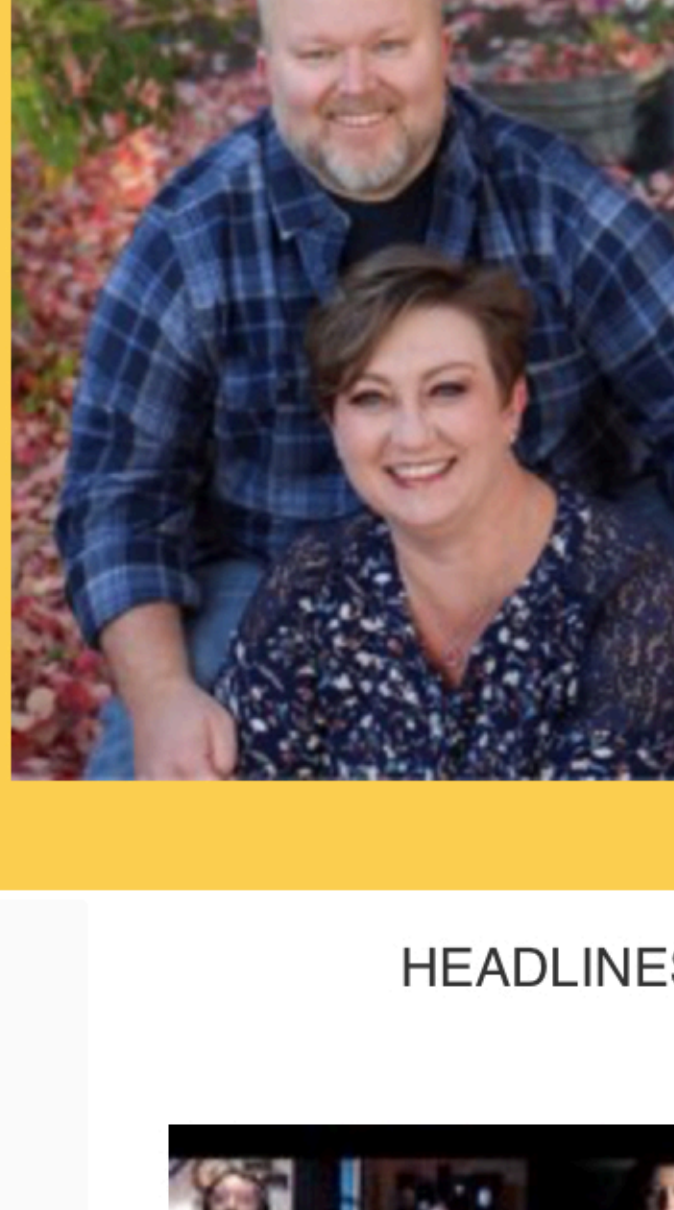

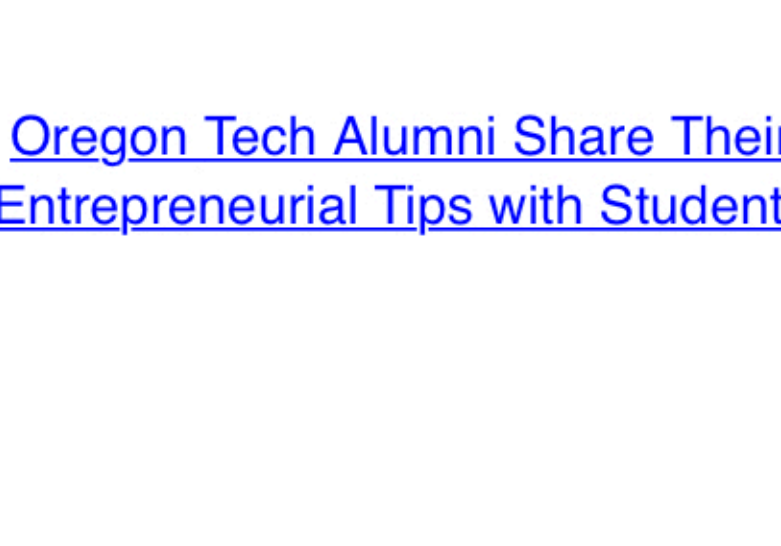
Alumni Spotlight

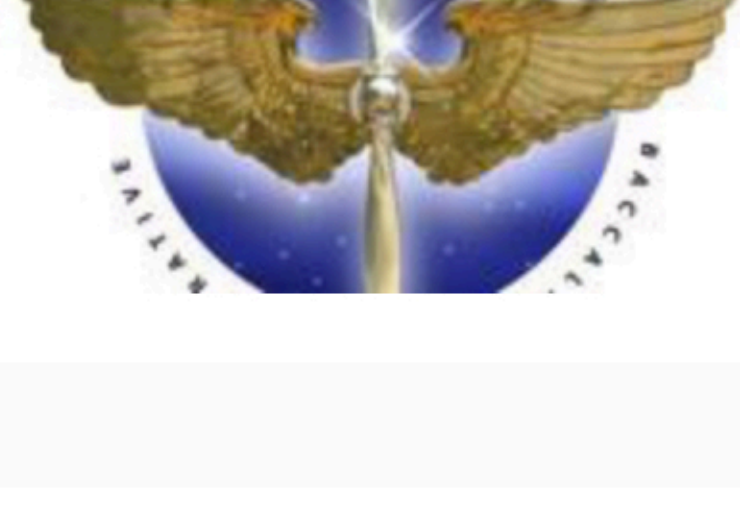

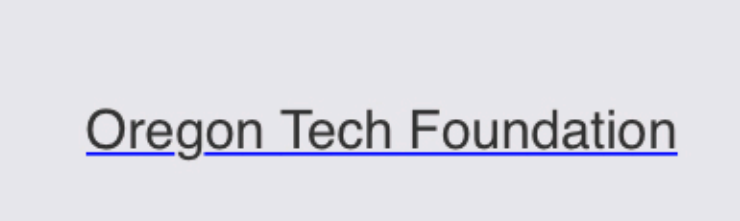
