


ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT




Oregon Tech Together:



ALUMNI-OWNED BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT

Brandon Little '10 and John Grieser '11 are the owners of Elemental Energy, a solar PV system design and installation firm based in Portland, and Twende Solar, their non-profit organization dedicated to empowering energy-deficient populations with renewable energy systems.

Elemental Energy is a full-service solar, energy storage & electrical contractor, for both commercial and residential projects, with clients such as Multnomah County, 10 Barrel Brewing, Boys & Girls Club, Nike, and hundreds of happy homeowners.



In an effort to bridge the gap between the solar industry and communities in need, Twende Solar is the non-profit started by the alumni. On a mission to provide a "world with sustainable energy for all," they have installed solar in Nicaragua, Cambodia, Guatemala, Peru, Baja California, Haiti, and Tanzania. These village-sized systems are initiated by requests and partnerships with other non-profits groups. The word "twende" means "let's go" in Swahili, which is what they named their organization. In addition to the international projects, Twende also completed a local project, installing a 100kW solar array for the Portland Rescue Mission's women's shelter. The project was completed entirely with the help of 196 local and industry volunteers.


