We hire and train paid mentors, called Friends. Each Friend is paired with eight at-risk first-graders, whom they will mentor for the next twelve years.

A Friend spends 16 hours per month with each child, both in and out of school, engaging them in an array of academic and enrichment activities designed to build basic life-skill, self-confidence, academic success and resiliency. Because Friends of the Children is a holistic, comprehensive program, we are actively involved in each child's development.
