

Save time by answering this list of questions before completing the Oregon Tech Application for Admissions. The Admissions department is always standing by to answer questions and help guide students through the application process. You will be able to save your work if you do not finish in one session.

1. Which OIT campus will you attend (Klamath Falls, Portland, etc.)?
2. Which term do you plan to start at Oregon Tech (Fall, Summer, etc.)?
3. In what major do you intend to enroll?
4. What is your social security number?
5. What is your legal name (first, middle and last)?
6. What is your mailing address?
7. What is your permanent address?
8. What is your phone number?
9. What is your e-mail address?
10. What is your gender?
11. What is your date of birth?
12. Are you a citizen of the United States? If not, are you a U.S. Permanent Resident? Of which country are you a citizen?
13. What is your ethnic identity?
14. What was the name of the high school you attended? In what year did you graduate from this school? Note: Have an official high-school transcript sent to the Oregon Tech Admissions Office unless you have completed at least 36 quarter hours of college credit or graduated from high school prior to 1997.
15. Are you being home-educated or are you a home-school graduate?
16. For current high school students - List classes that are in progress and/or will be completed after the conclusion of the 11<sup>th</sup> grade.
17. Have you passed two years of one foreign language in high school or two terms of one foreign language (including American Sign Language) in college, or will you have done so prior to enrolling at Oregon Tech?
18. Standardized Test Information = Please be able to provide dates that exams were taken (SAT's, ACT's or GED's) if any of these apply to you. Dates can be listed on the application and then official score reports should be submitted to the Admissions Office.

Note: If you have completed fewer than 36 quarter hours of college credit, you must submit official SAT I or ACT results to Oregon Tech's Admissions Office, **unless** your scores appear on your high-school transcript **or** you graduated from high school more than three years ago.

19. List school, civic or other activities in which you have been involved and/or would like to become involved at Oregon Tech (e.g., clubs, sports, student government).
20. List every college or university you have attended or are currently attending or from which you will receive credit (including Oregon Tech) in the order in which they were attended. Have official academic transcripts from each school sent to the Oregon Tech Admissions Office.
21. If you are over 24 years of age and/or married and you plan on claiming Oregon residency for tuition purposes you will need:
  - Dates of most recent continuous presence in Oregon
  - Original date of Oregon driver's license
  - Dates of military service (If applicable)
  - Military service entered while in Oregon (If applicable)
  - Last two years you have filed Oregon income taxes
  - Employer information (names of last two employers, cities, states, dates of employment)Note: If you are under the age of 24 and unmarried, you will have to provide the preceding information for either a parent or guardian.
22. Emergency Information: List a parent, legal guardian, other relative or friend who knows where you can be reached.
23. Do you intend to live on campus?
24. Have either of your parents (or guardians) earned a bachelor's degree (4-year degree) from any college or university in the past?

When you have completed the application, you will be asked to read and affirm the following statement before submitting your application to Oregon Tech:

*I understand that withholding information requested on this application, including attendance at any other institution, or giving false information may make me ineligible for admission to the university or subject to dismissal.*
