2001-2002 GRADUATE SURVEY Highlights of the Class of 2002

OIT's Class of 2002 was very successful especially in light of the economic downturn of the past two years. Of 248 graduates for whom we have information (60% of graduates), 94% were either employed, continuing their education, or inactive (not seeking employment). The other 6% were actively seeking employment at the time of the survey. Of those employed, 91% were in career-related positions. Average salaries rose overall for nine of fifteen bachelor's degrees for which comparison data is available and the average salary for all graduates increased 7.5%. Fewer graduates found employment in Oregon than last year. Bachelor of Science graduates went back to school in larger numbers.

This annual report is based on a survey of Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT) students completing graduation requirements between August 2001 and June 2002. It is intended to provide information about graduate outcomes to members of the OIT community, employers, and other interested publics. The information contained in the report can also be used to facilitate the career decisions of currently enrolled and prospective OIT students.

- 91% of employed grads were in career-related positions
