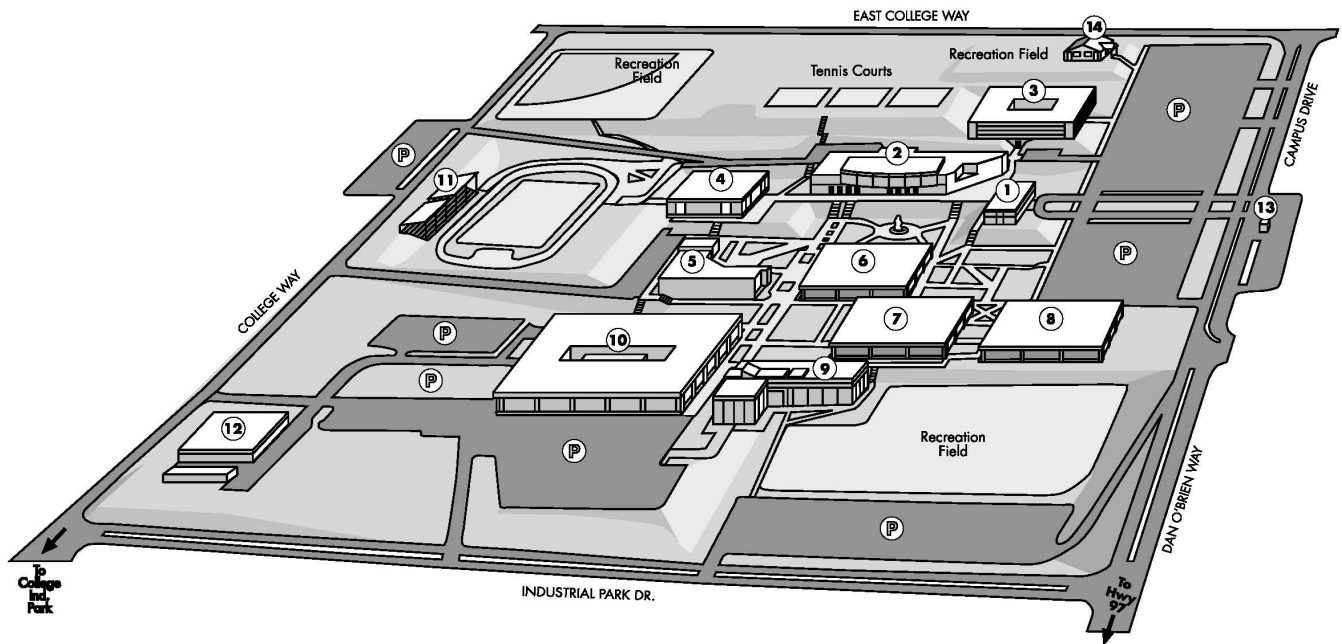

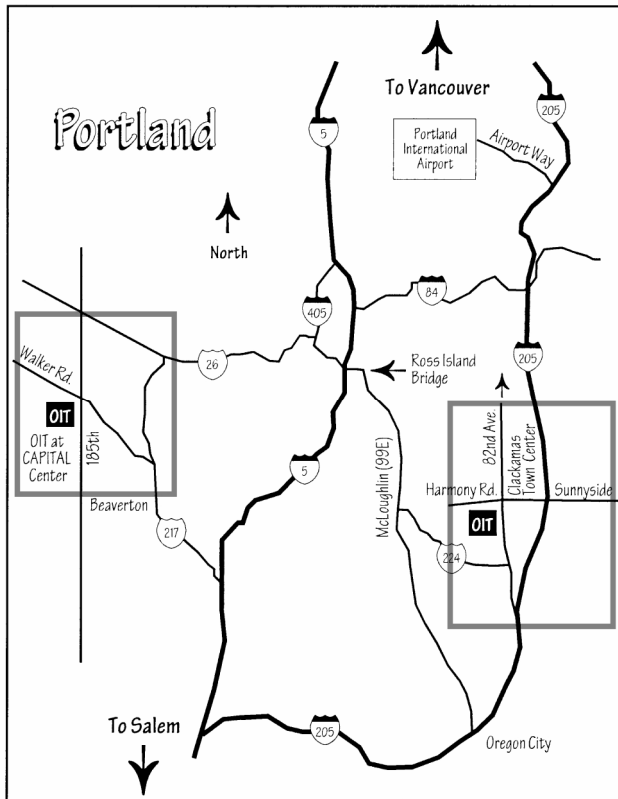

6.5 OIT – PORTLAND OPERATIONS

Both the Metro Center (East Campus) and CAPITAL Center (West Campus) are conveniently located. The Metro Center location is just off Highway 205 near the Clackamas Town Center. The CAPITAL Center location is just off Highway 26, on the corner of 185th and Walker Road in Beaverton.

OIT's CAPITAL Center location is part of the Oregon University System's commitment to workforce development in the Portland area.

OIT also offers degree completion programs in Clinical Laboratory Science (B.S.), on the Oregon Health & Science University campus in Portland; in Paramedic Education (A.A.S.), at the Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue facility in Sherwood; and in Renewable Energy Systems at Clackamas Community College's Wilsonville Training Center.
