NOTE: Student/Faculty Ratio is the result of dividing Student FTE by Faculty FTE. Student FTE is based on all credit hours (SCH) generated within each course. For undergraduates, one FTE equals total SCH divided by 15, for Master's students, one FTE equals total SCH divided by 12. Faculty FTE (non-Distance Ed.) is calculated as total credit hours reported on faculty contracts divided by 12.
